

# MultNoMo Circulator Guide

## Who Can Sign

Active registered voters of Multnomah County or the City of Portland.

### Common disqualifiers:

- Inactive registration (moved recently, unresolved ballot issue)
- "Portland" address actually in unincorporated Clackamas/Washington County

Signers can check registration at [sos.or.gov](https://sos.or.gov) and residence at [PortlandMaps.com](https://PortlandMaps.com)

## Collecting Signatures

You, the circulator, must witness each signature—actually watch them sign, not just be nearby.

Each signer provides four things in blue or black ink:

<b>Signature</b>	"Use the signature you use when you vote"
<b>Date</b>	Actual date signed (MM/DD/YY)
<b>Printed Name</b>	Clearly printed
<b>Residence Address</b>	Full street address, city, zip—no PO Boxes

Complete the certification at the bottom immediately after collecting signatures.

Once certified, that sheet is closed; use a fresh sheet for more.

## Mailing Sheets

### Before You Mail

- No one printed their name in the signature box?
- All addresses include city and zip?
- You signed the certification?

- 1-3 sheets? Trifold into letter envelope with 1 Forever stamp
- 4 or more? Mail flat in 9x12 envelope with 3 Forever stamps

## Legal

Signers may only sign once. Circulators may submit as many sheets as they like.

MultNoMo uses only volunteer circulators. Oregon law prohibits paying per signature.

**Circulators may not:** submit known false signatures, seek signatures from unqualified voters, make false statements about the petition, offer anything of value for signatures, alter signer info without initials.
